Club Competition Handicaps for Ladies

At a Ladies Quorum meeting on Thursday April 4th 2024 a decision was made to revise the Competition Handicaps in line with those being calculated by the Mens Handicap system.

WINNERS OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR are allocated a handicap of

- Presidents Trophy: handicap 7 This is to signify the huge number of competitors that they have been in competition with
- Two Woods: handicap 6 This form of the game takes particular skill and accuracy, and was deemed to earn the right of a handicap of 6
- Winning more than one competition 6 When players win more than one high status competition then their handicap is calculated as a 6
- Championship: handicap 5
 As there were only 8 entrants it was felt this was not a true indication of a bowler's handicap status. In future years this may be increased to a handicap of 6, if entrant numbers increase.
- Handicap: handicap 5
- Mixed Pairs: handicap 5 Because of the large entries in this competition it was felt that a handicap of 5 was suitable
- *Triples: handicap 4
- *Pairs: handicap 4
- Cribb: handicap 3

* It is far harder to calculate handicaps for winning multiplayer competitions as there is a big difference in the handicaps of each member of the drawn teams.

• Runners up will be given a handicap of one point lower than the winner.

THERE IS SOME FLEXIBILITY in calculating Handicaps when using this system as a guideline - anomalies may occur which need the Quorum's discretion in order to resolve these issues.

All the above will be reviewed yearly, depending on the number of entries in each competition, and the bowler's progress/ handicap of the year(s) before.
